On the top of each journal page, you see questions like, What is God telling you about Himself? About Yourself? About Others? And is there anything He is asking you to Do? These questions are meant to help you focus on how the Bible story/verse applies to your life. As you journal, try to think of what God is saying to you. What do you want to talk to God about? Is God showing you anything or anyone that you could pray for?

You can talk to God about anything, anytime, and anywhere. Before you begin to listen and journal, it's a good idea to start by quieting yourself and praying. You can pray your own prayer or use the example prayer below. Prayer helps us to focus our time on the conversation we're about to have with God.

As I think about the Bible story, help me to hear what you are saying to me through it.
