Let's Begin

On the top of each journal page, you see questions like, What is God telling you about Himself? About Yourself? About Others? And is there anything He is asking you to Do? These questions are meant to help you focus on how the Bible story/verse of the week applies to your life. As you journal, try to think of what God is saying to you. What do you want to talk to God about? Is God showing you anything or anyone that you could pray for?

You can talk to God about anything, anytime, and anywhere. Before you begin to listen and journal, it's a good idea to start by quieting yourself and praying. You can pray your own prayer or use the example prayer below. Prayer helps us to focus our time on the conversation we're about to have with God.

Dear Father,

Hi, it's me. I've come to spend time with you. I have many things that I want to tell you about, and I want to listen to what you have to say to me. As I think about the Bible story, help me to hear what you are saying to me through it. When others share their journaling page, help me to listen and teach me to pray for them according to your will (Romans 8:26-27).
